### Minutes from July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2006 Club Meeting

The July 2nd meeting of the WRC was called to order by President Fred Foster at 10:08 AM at the 4-H flying site with many members in attendance. The minutes from the June meeting were read by Secretary Kurt Smith. In Treasurer Roger Leighton's absence, President Fred Foster presented the treasurer's report which after the previous month's transactions showed a new balance of \$1171.33. Both reports were duly moved, seconded, and approved unanimously by the members present.

Under old/new business their was discussion about V.P. Roger Buckers presentation of the Boy Scout's Aviation Merit Badge one day program. The program is to bring the Scouts to the 4-H field and they will go through three distinct segments. Theory of flight, simulator stations, and actual hands on with an instructor and a buddy boxed trainer plane. The discussion was very positive and proceeded to a motion to accept the plan. It was seconded and approved unanimously by the members present.

Kurt Smith presented that he is waiting on several responses about a porta-potty and will present it to the members at the next meeting. He also has requested a delay on discussing the club By-Law changes until the following meeting to give it more time to develop them more thoroughly with members and the AMA before presenting them to the membership.

Kurt Smith reported on the Moultonborough Airport. He reported that a runway, pit area, and parking had been mowed but as of yet no one has test flown at the site. Over the next few weeks, several members have shown interest in test flying at the site to see if it should be developed further. The information will be reported back to the membership at the next meeting.

Ed Devereaux asked what the club rule was on using the starting stands and weather members should be leaving their planes on the stands when they were not in use. The members discussed a problem with the spacing between the stands that prevented moving the planes off the stands and on to

the grass. A motion was made to move the stand further apart to make room to put planes on the ground when not in use. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously by the members present.

There remains 3 gallons of 15% nitro club fuel for sale.
