Minutes from March 7th, 2006 Club Meeting

The March 7th meeting of the WRC was called to order by Co-President Fred Foster at 7:30 PM in the airport terminal building. Treasurer Roger Leighton presented the treasurer's report which after the previous month's transactions showed a new balance of \$1677.36. Roger noted that only 29 member have paid for the 2006 year. Both reports were duly moved, seconded, and approved unanimously by the members present. Under
