Minutes from May 7th, 2006 Club Meeting

The May 7th meeting of the WRC was called to order by Co-President Fred Foster at 10:06 AM in the airport flying site with a large group of member in attendance. The minutes from the April meeting were read by Secretary Kurt Smith. Treasure Roger Leighton presented the treasurer's report which after the previous month's transactions showed a new balance of \$246.18. Roger noted that there have been substantial donations for the new 4-H flying site. Both reports were duly moved, seconded, and approved unanimously by the members present. V.P. David Birdsey has requested to step down from his position and Roger Bucker has

stepped up to fill in the position. The member ship was asked if they supported the change. The members approved the change unanimously.

Under old business their was the continued discussion about the new 4-H flying site and all of the work to be done. Also discussed was the weekend schedule of dates in which the club will not be able to use the site because of events at the fairgrounds. It was suggested by Max Rothmund that the membership volunteer to 'park cars' during the Belknap County Fair so that we could park cars around the new runway and not on it. Discussion about the new gate and flying alone at the field were also discussed.

Remaining Nitro fuel was dis-

cussed and many members said they would take several gallons if it was 15% and not 10%. The club will look into exchanging the fuel for 15% in Nashua.

A press release was approved that would go out to as many sources as possible. Some members would still like to address the subject of being asked to leave the airport. The press release addresses it but not in detail.

The insurance on the Laconia Airport site was discussed and will be removed effective May 13th at 11:59 PM and placed on the new 4-H site at 12:00 AM May 14th. All flying at Laconia will stop on Saturday.

Jim Beck won the pool and asked that the money be given back to the club. ☺

NEW 4-H FAIRGROUNDS AIRFIELD

The 4-H fair grounds in Belmont is looking great. The new runway is 400 X 60 feet in size and is now mowed. See the pictures below for the progress that is being made. Any help at the site is needed with setting up the safety fence, digging holes, raking, and mowing.

The new club mower arrived on Tuesday and was put to work right away mowing the runway and parking lot area. The frequency box is up and the safety fence is in. The posts for the gate were dug into the ground on Wednesday and Fred Foster bought a trailer to move the clubs mower from the 4-H field to the Parade Road field and for storage. There is no secure storage at the sites to keep the mower so it will be trailered between members.
