Minutes from November 5th, 2006 Club Meeting

The **November 5th** meeting of the WRC was called to order by President Fred Foster at **10:00AM** AM at the 4-H flying site with many members in attendance. The minutes from the October meeting were read by Secretary Kurt Smith. Treasurer Roger Leighton presented the treasurer's report which after the previous month's transactions showed a new balance of \$724.49. Both reports were duly moved, seconded, and approved unanimously by the members present.

NEW BUSINESS:

New Members: Brian MacKay from Danbury was unanimously approved by the members.

There was discussion about the fun fly and how to approach the event as a paid to fly event in the future to help off-set the cost of putting on such an event.

The members discussed the new dues and the different classes of registration and their associated cost. It was agreed on that the membership is as follows for the start of the 2007 season:

Senior Member: \$30.00

Family: \$35.00

Kid/Junior (under AMA age limit): \$1.00

Non-Flying Member: \$15.00

Initiation Fee: \$3.00

All members, except Non-Flying, must have and maintain a current AMA membership.

President Fred Foster made a request for as many members to be available for the work detail on Saturday, November 18th to work on pulling rocks and filling the holes in at the field.

There was a request for an updated roster to be given to members. A question was posed to the members if they had an issue with their phone number and email address being given to other members. There was no opposition to this.

A request was made by Secretary

Kurt Smith to update the State of New Hampshire records to reflect the current board members. Their was a motion, seconded, and moved by the members to approve the update.

Max Rothemund had raised a concern that the club is not exempt for Federal Tax. Kurt Smith will look into the status of Federal Government Tax Exempt status for the club as they are registered in the State of New Hampshire as such.

A request for the NO-FLY dates from the 4-H for 2007 was made but at this time the dates have not been set. As soon as they are available, they will be posted on the website, the field, and forwarded to the members via email.
